## Electrical Engineering Lab (Pr, P, 4<sup>th</sup> Semester) - International Studies of Engineering (ISE)

The lab will start on **21.04.2017** and will take place every **Friday** starting at **9:00, 12:30** and **15:30**, respectively. The **registration** via the moodle-course "Praktikum GET" (link below) is open **from 01.04.2017 to 20.04.2017 (12:00)**.

**The participation of the safety briefing "Gefahren des elektrischen Stroms" is mandatory to attend the lab!**

For the registration, you have to enter your personal data into a database first and confirm that you have attended the above-mentioned event. Afterwards, you must book an appointment of your choice for each experiment. **The booked dates are binding.**

The lab consists of 4 experiments, of which all 4 experiments have to be completed successfully, to pass the lab. In the case of an unsuccessful experiment, the entire lab has to be repeated in the next year.

**Each participant has in total one additional attempt to compensate for a single unsuccessful experiment.**

It is assumed that each participant has prepared thoroughly before the appropriate experiment on the basis of the lab documents. The corresponding documents are available for download on the following websites:

The test evaluation is carried out immediately during the lab so that correspondingly necessary working material such as millimeter paper, calculator etc. are to be brought along.

**An inadequate preparation or missing work material leads to the exclusion from the experiment.** This is considered as an unsuccessful experiment.

At the beginning of each experiment a written test will take place. If the test is not passed, this experiment is considered unsuccessful and can be repeated in a follow-up date (see above).

**Each participant has to show a valid photo ID before the start of each experiment!** Otherwise, participation is not possible leading to an unsuccessful experiment.

The lab as well as the test will be held in German only.

Furthermore, a non-appearance also leads to an unsuccessful experiment. In the case of illness, a medical certificate is required, which must have been received by the responsible supervisor of the corresponding experiment within 3 working days after the date of the experiment, so that this test is not considered as an unsuccessful experiment.

A registration for the lab in the following semester is required in any case!
